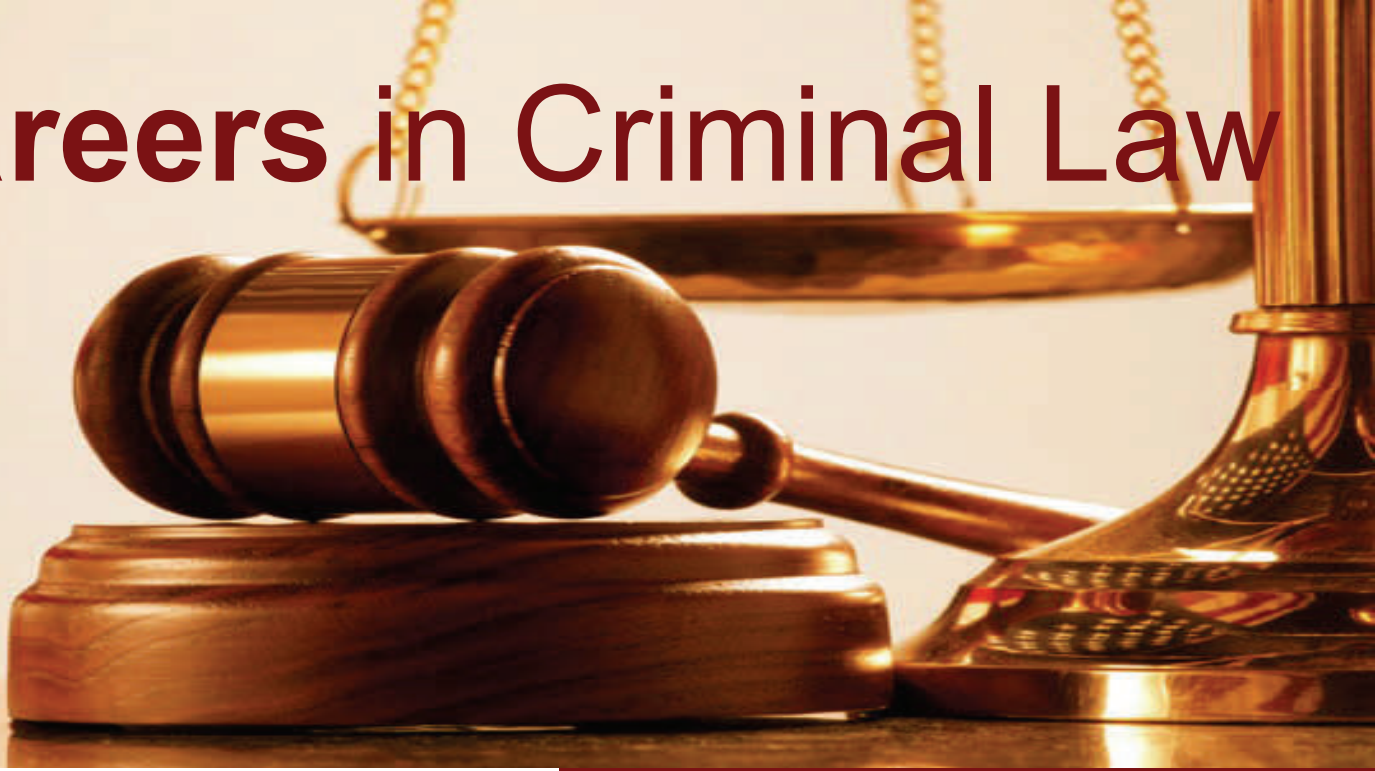


Careers in Criminal Law
