Summary

Congressman Jim Langevin (Rhode Island) is a recognized leader and expert in the House of Representatives on cybersecurity issues. Securing our nation's technology infrastructure against cyber attacks is a top priority for Congressman Langevin. As the Co-Founder and Co-Chairman of the bipartisan [House Cybersecurity Caucus](#), he has taken on a leadership role in raising awareness of cybersecurity issues in Congress and fostering dialogue and debate on the critical questions surrounding this topic. In addition, he is working to implement the recommendations of the Center for Strategic and International Studies (CSIS) [Commission on Cyber Security for the 44th Presidency](#), which Congressman Langevin co-chaired. While chairing the House Homeland Security Subcommittee on Emerging Threats, Cybersecurity, and Science and Technology, he led numerous hearings and inquiries focused upon cybersecurity, critical infrastructure, and homeland security issues.

Congressman Langevin will discuss how the cyber threat affects our national and economic security, what steps need to be taken to protect national assets and promote cybersecurity, and why lawyers in both the public and private sector need to be closely involved in cybersecurity developments.
