Note that this text does not include everything from ASFA, such as amendments to other parts of federal law (e.g., Title IV-D of the Social Security Act changes related to use of the federal parent locator service in child welfare cases) or amendments that go directly into U.S. Code as notes (e.g., the schedule for filing termination petitions). We believe that this "cut and paste" version of what federal child welfare, foster care, and adoption law now looks like will be useful to children's advocates and will help folks better understand the significance and impact of the Adoption and Safe Families Act.
