HOTEL INFORMATION

Loews Annapolis Hotel, located at 126 West Street in the historic seaport of Annapolis, Maryland, is a 25-minute drive from both Baltimore and Washington, D.C., and only 18 miles from Baltimore-Washington International Airport (BWI). Room rates are \$199, single or double, plus 12% tax per room per night. A very limited number of rooms are also available for government employees at the rate of \$120 single or double. Parking rates range from \$8-\$22 per day.

You may reserve your accommodations at Loews Annapolis Hotel by calling the hotel directly at 410-263-7777 and guaranteeing your reservation by credit card or deposit check. **Please refer to the ABA Public Contract Law 16th Annual Federal Procurement Institute.** Rooms will be available for check-in after 3:00 p.m. with a check-out time of 12:00 noon. Early arrivals or late departures will be booked on an availability basis. Individuals with guaranteed reservations must cancel their reservations by 48 hours prior to the scheduled day of arrival to avoid a one night's cancellation charge.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION

Super Shuttle operates a van/bus service between BWI and Annapolis. Information about this service can be obtained by calling 800-258-3826. The cost is \$35 per person each way.
