

Elderbar Basics

Goal:

Elderbar is an open discussion forum for professionals in law and aging.

Membership:

Subscription to Elderbar is limited to professional in the fields of law and aging. Elderbar is a closed membership list.

Discussion forum:

Elderbar is a discussion forum. Replies to postings on the list are sent to all list subscribers. To send private or “off-the-list” replies change the “to” address on your posting or forward the message to the person you wish to receive it. The managers reserve the right to temporarily switch the list from “reply-to-all” to “reply-to-sender” to control the flow of messages.

Content limitations:

Posting commercial materials on Elderbar is prohibited. Announcements of potential interest to list members of conferences, workshops, trainings, and publications (even if they are “for sale”), are not considered commercial materials. Members, who post commercial materials to the list, may be unsubscribed.

Editorial neutrality:

Elderbar is an open discussion forum. The views expressed on the list reflect the views or policy of the poster and not the views or policy of the American Bar Association or the ABA Commission on Law and Aging. There are two sides to every issue. Membership is not limited based on philosophy or point of view.

Abusive postings:

Discussion and postings on Elderbar should maintain a reasonable and civil tone. Posters who post offensive or insulting materials to the list may be unsubscribed. If you wish to enter into a personal discussion with another member, please reply off the list using the directions above.
