

Summary of the Standards Review Committee Public Hearing on April 12, 2018

The Standards Review Committee (SRC) of the Council of the ABA Section of Legal Education and Admissions to the Bar hosted a public hearing on April 12, 2018, in Washington, D.C., to receive oral comment on proposals to alter standards and rules of the [ABA Standards and Rules of Procedure for Approval of Law Schools](#).
