**Resolution on the Accreditation of Foreign Law Schools
December 2010**

Consistent with the first recommendation of the Kane Committee report and in view of the comments received by the Council with respect to that report, the Council shall continue with its consideration of the approval of foreign law schools and engage in its consideration appropriate public and private stakeholders, for example, the Conference of Chief Justices, state bar examiners, legal educators, representatives of the legal profession, and public officials. Until the Council has fully vetted the issue as to whether to expand the accreditation role of the Section to encompass law schools located outside of the U.S. and its territories, the Section will not proceed with consideration of any application for provisional approval from a foreign law school.
