



I write to endorse the letter, dated August 8, that you have received from various law school deans supporting the action taken with regard to the new Employment Outcomes Public Disclosure Form that the Council approved in June. I feel strongly that the American Bar Association should adopt a form that most accurately reflects the employment outcomes of our students. And, that form should not treat school-funded positions that meet the ABA definition of full-time employment differently from other funded positions, particularly given that these positions play a critical role in helping students launch careers in public service.
