

Vijay V. Bondada is a Vice-President at Pfizer Inc., one of the world's leading pharmaceutical companies. Mr. Bondada joined Pfizer's Litigation Department in 2007, where he supervised successful litigation and regulatory strategies relating to some of the company's key product lines. In addition, he played a central role in formulating a highly effective insurance claims strategy that has yielded unprecedented insurance recoveries for the Company. Before joining Pfizer, he spent nearly 13 years representing pharmaceutical and biotechnology companies at some of the nation's premiere law firms, including Skadden Arps and Reed Smith, on a variety of complex regulatory and litigation matters.
