



Out-of-State Attorneys Can Temporarily Register For NC Free Legal Answers To Respond To Hurricane Florence-Related Questions

NOTE: Attorneys not licensed in North Carolina who wish to provide limited pro bono services through NC Free Legal Answers must first complete the North Carolina State Bar Registration for Temporary Practice of North Carolina Law (Rule .0905(h)): www.ncbar.gov/for-lawyers/forms. By registering for NC Free Legal Answers following the steps below, you are affirming that you have already sent the NC State Bar your Temporary Practice Registration form.

1. Go to nc.freelegalanswers.org.
2. Click on “**Volunteer Attorney Registration**” at the top of the site.
3. Read and agree to **Attorney Agreement**.
4. Fill out registration information.
 - Note: Attorneys not licensed in NC, when prompted to select the county in NC “Where You Primarily Practice,” select “**ABA Natural Disaster Assistance (Out of State)**.”
5. **Click on the activation link** sent to your email (check spam folder).
6. After you click the activation link, **you will receive a welcome email** from the NC Bar Foundation requesting you to confirm whether or not you have sent your Registration for Temporary Practice of North Carolina Law Form to the NC State Bar.

Once your account is approved, you can sign in to nc.freelegalanswers.org, filter by Subject and respond to questions in the available “Hurricane Florence” categories.

- Click on “**Training Resources**” to find disaster related resources to assist you in answering questions.
- **Malpractice Insurance is provided** by the ABA to out-of-state attorney volunteers participating in NC Free Legal Answers.
- **If licensed outside of North Carolina, your attorney account will be automatically disabled on January 16, 2019, pursuant to the North Carolina Supreme Court Order.**
