IX. Travel Information

You are encouraged to make your airline reservations online via the American Bar Association (ABA) travel site where you automatically receive specially negotiated ABA airfare and car rental discounts from a variety of carriers. Please note: to enter Argentina, a valid passport is required by all nationals. A Visa for Argentina is also required for nationals from certain countries. The Argentine Government requires that citizens of USA, Canada and Australia satisfy a Reciprocity Fee requirement before traveling. You can pay this fee online at the Argentine Embassy website of your country or by checking the website of your airline carrier. Failure to provide proof of payment upon arrival will result in denied entry and return to passenger's point of departure. Please contact your nearest Argentina Embassy for information on what documentation you may require to enter Argentina.

X. Special Event Descriptions

Hospitality Night: On Tuesday, October 21, members of the Buenos Aires legal community will host Fall Meeting foreign attendees at their homes for a "Hospitality Night." Attendees may bring along accompanying guests, spouses, and/or significant others. Coordination and transportation will be agreed among host and guests closer to the event.
