*Substantive Committees*

**Alternative Dispute Resolution**

Develops training opportunities and provides a forum for lawyers interested in arbitration, mediation and other forms of dispute resolution.

**Elder Law**

Studies the options and problems connected with long-term care planning, healthcare, Medicare and Medicaid, retirement planning, advising senior clients, families of seniors, and end-of-life decision-making.

**Elder Law – Guardianship & Fiduciaries**

Identifies current issues and concerns in the areas of guardianships, conservatorships and powers of attorney, especially as they impact financial abuse or exploitation of seniors. Encourages enhanced knowledge, ethical behavior and professionalism for individual and professional guardians, conservators and other fiduciaries.

**Elder Law – Litigation**

Identifies and comments upon issues of unique concern to the elder law community that involve litigation of elder abuse; financial overreaching; and traditional areas of concern such as the guardianships, will contests, and trust accounting from the point of view of the elder. Encourages practitioners to develop and respect the unique circumstances of an elder engaged in litigation.

**Elder Law – Real Estate**

**Estate Planning**

Identifies key issues related to preparing estate plans and communicates comments relating to issues to Division members.

**Ethics & Professionalism**

Gathers and disseminates information, and prepares articles for Division publications, on ethical and professionalism issues and concerns that are of particular interest to senior lawyers.

**Family Issues**

Identifies and advises on issues of concern to seniors such as generational conflicts, second or late marriages and divorces, and grandparents' visitation rights.

**Intergenerational (IGEN)**

The Committee was formed for advice in preparing the SLD's intergenerational debate on Social Security, Medicare and Medicaid at the Chicago annual meeting in 2009.

Subsequently, issues involving Social Security and the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act have been circulated to the Committee. The committee may receive discrete assignments from SLD management regarding these matters.

**International Issues**

Encourages senior lawyers to become “involved” in international projects, e.g., participating with foreign lawyers in CLE programs, teaching abroad and, in partnership with the International Senior Lawyers Project in New York City, responding to requests from bars in developing countries to provide legal assistance on specific matters.

**Investment Strategies**

Produces articles and programs and plan to provide an on-line forum for discussing investment alternatives and issues of interest to lawyers and their families, including investing for retirement, tax and insurance strategies at various stages of a legal career, and how to get the best investment advice.

**Judiciary**

The Judiciary Committee focuses on the relationship of judging to age; from the standpoint of the judge as an older person to issues especially relevant to older parties and older lawyers. Current projects include possible production of a webinar in conjunction with the National Judicial College.

**Lifestyles & Leisure**

This new committee focuses on life issues outside of law practice and legal concerns. Its two subcommittees are (1) Health & Fitness and (2) Travel. Additional subcommittees are being formed to cover other pursuits, including food and wine, book and other media and technology reviews, and lifestyle profiles of SLD members. It will also serve as a platform for including opportunities to enjoy each other's company at SLD meetings or at extensions to meetings.

**Practicing Senior Lawyers**

Develops and promotes publications, programs and projects which assist experienced lawyers in the continuation of full and part-time practice of law, including Of Counsel arrangements, and successful transition to new careers and/or retirement.
