Dr. M. Christine Kenty, co-principal of QUAD2 Consulting, is an ABA CCL evaluation consultant on recorded forensic interviews and children's testimony. She has consulted within the CAC movement on a local, regional and national level since 1989. Her manual, **A Guide to Case Review for CACs**, is available to members for download from the NCA website. She is currently evaluating the Northeast Regional CAC's Leadership Exchange and Coaching Project, and (with Weiss Associates) she conducted the National Children's Alliance 2004 strategic planning process using an Appreciative Inquiry approach to individual interviews and regional focus groups. She has provided training and evaluation for NCA and NRCAC on assessing forensic interviewing, multidisciplinary case review, protocol development, and strategic planning, teaming and program evaluation. She consults with CACs in Pennsylvania, New Jersey, New York, Maryland and Georgia. She recently completed a five-year qualitative research project with pediatric residents at Children's Hospital of Philadelphia.

Dr. Kenty is Director of Research and Evaluation for the Support Center for Child Advocates in Philadelphia, where she developed or assisted with all client data collection and program evaluations since 1981, including recent outcomes data methods internally and with the *Child Advocates*-led National Children's Law Network. With Frank Cervone, she co-authored the article on quality review and outcomes measurement for the 2006 NACC Child Welfare Law Office Guidebook.
