

## Eva J. Klain, J.D.

Eva Klain works on legal projects addressing crimes against children at the ABA Center on Children and the Law. As director of the Center's child and adolescent health projects, she researches and analyzes legal responses to the health and developmental needs of infants and toddlers, substance abuse, teen pregnancy, statutory rape, domestic trafficking of children for sexual exploitation and other issues. She has published several monographs, manuals and a bench book on criminal prosecution issues, including monographs on the prostitution of children and child sex tourism and the criminal justice system response to child pornography. Ms. Klain previously worked on criminal child abuse issues for the National Center for Prosecution of Child Abuse and spent a year working with the High Court of Prague to improve the Czech Republic's response to child maltreatment. Ms. Klain received her Bachelor of Arts degree from Cornell University in 1986 and her law degree, *cum laude*, from Georgetown University in 1989.
