SECTION POLICY FOR

PUBLICATION OF COMMITTEE WORK PRODUCT

Committees of the ABA Section of Public Contract Law regularly generate or identify work product that contains valuable analyses of cases, proposed or enacted procurement rules, statutes, policies, or issues. A Committee may seek to make such work product publicly available on the Section's website, or in hard copy format, without publishing the work product pursuant to the Section's technical comment authority or the ABA blanket authority process.

The Section believes that Committees should be able to make their work product accessible to the broadest possible audience, consistent with ABA policy regarding formal communications on behalf of the ABA or the Sections of the ABA. To facilitate to the maximum possible extent the dissemination of Committee work product in compliance with ABA policy, the Council of the Section of Public Contract Law adopts the following procedure which must be followed by a Section Committee prior to publication of its work product.

Committee work product covered by this procedure – This procedure applies to all work product that a Section Committee intends to publish, including, but not limited to, White Papers, position papers, comments, and case summaries. To be designated as a Committee White Paper, the work product must contain an impartial and comprehensive analysis of a legal issue, rule, statute, or policy relevant to public contracting.

Pre-Publication Review – Before publication, all Committee work product must be submitted to the Vice-Chair of the Section of Public Contract Law for a review to determine whether the work product should be subject to the procedures governing the Section's technical comment authority or the ABA's blanket authority process. The Vice-Chair may also consider the relevance of the subject matter to the Section's work and the quality of the research and analysis supporting the work product in deciding whether to permit publication.
