## Driving Them To Sobriety: The Mechanics of Creating and Operating a DWI/Drug Court

Interested in starting or improving a DWI/Drug Court in your jurisdiction? At the American Bar Association's Annual Meeting in San Francisco, there will be a panel presentation on establishing and operating DWI Courts. *Driving them to Sobriety, The Mechanics of Creating and Operating a DWI/Drug Court* is sponsored by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.

After an introduction by Missouri Chief Justice William Ray Price, the session will begin with an overview by a judge who runs one of the four nationally-recognized DWI/Drug Academy Courts. A Judicial Outreach Liaison and member of the National Association of Drug Court Professionals will provide a detailed ethical review of DWI/Drug Court operations. We will then turn to the important issue of how to fund your DWI/Drug Court in this era of scarce resources. The basics of building a DWI/Drug Court team will be presented by the NHTSA/ABA Judicial Fellow who will be followed by a leading prosecutor and defense attorney to discuss the role that each plays in the operation of the DWI/Drug Court team.
