Reinvigorating U.S. chemical management policy is a top priority for EPA under Administrator Jackson. A key player in this effort is Steve Owens, Assistant Administrator for EPA's Office of Chemical Safety and Pollution Prevention. Prior to becoming the Assistant Administrator, Mr. Owens served as Director of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality and, before that, practiced as an environmental attorney for 14 years.
