**WRITING FOR *TRENDS***

The bimonthly newsletter *Trends* is published by the American Bar Association's Section of Environment, Energy, and Resources, for the Section's members. The newsletter is one of the Section's primary vehicles for relaying timely information on substantive issues and practice tips, Section-wide events, and significant committee activities.

**Content**

Two types of articles are generally considered appropriate for publication:

- Substantive articles of interest to a significant number of the Section's members. These articles should discuss practical applications of issues to membership practice areas.
- Articles about significant Section activities.

Articles must be original and should not have been previously published. ABA policy requires that the copyright owner of a *Trends* article sign an ABA Publication Agreement.

*Trends* articles run either:

- one page at 760 words, or
- two pages at 1,725 words.

*Trends* articles do not use footnotes or endnotes and should incorporate all citations in the text.

**Proposals**

The *Trends* editorial meets annually to plan upcoming issues but welcomes receiving article proposals throughout the year. Proposals should include short summary including the major points you would make in the article. Acceptance of articles for publication in *Trends* is subject to the discretion of the Editor-in-Chief. Articles about the activities of a Section committee should also be approved by that committee's chair.
