

Report of the Section of International Law (Midyear Meeting 1978)

BE IT RESOLVED, That the American Bar Association recommends that the Inter-American Convention of International Commercial Arbitration (1975) should be signed and ratified by the United States; provided that implementing legislation, or an appropriate resolution of advice and consent, or both, are prepared which are designed:

(a) to avoid conflicts with the Convention on Enforcement of Foreign Arbitral Awards (1958); and

(b) to provide appropriate safeguards with respect to future amendments in the IACAC Arbitration Rules.
