

Milwaukee Bar Association; Section of International Law and Practice (Midyear Meeting 1991)

BE IT RESOLVED, That the American Bar Association, in light of the passage by the Congress of the United States of Amendment 3068 to the Foreign Operations Appropriations Bill for fiscal year 1991 calling for the President and the Judicial Conference of the United States to explore the possibility of an international criminal court and report to the Congress by October 1, 1991, decides to establish a Blue Ribbon Committee on the Establishment of an International Criminal Court;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the President of the American Bar Association, in consultation with the Chairs of the Section of International Law and Practice, the Section of Criminal Justice, and the Judicial Administration Division, shall determine the structure, composition and mandate of the Blue Ribbon Committee, which shall present its report to the Board of Governors and the House of Delegates in time for their August 1991 meetings.
