

**Section of International Law and Practice (Midyear Meeting 1990)**

BE IT RESOLVED, That the American Bar Association recommends that a special high-level working group within the United States government be established by the President, in consultation with Congress, to determine:

- (a) what changes and clarifications would make Part XI of the 1982 United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea acceptable to the United States;
- (b) what steps should be taken to make these changes and clarifications acceptable to other nations; and
- (c) by what procedures these changes and clarifications can best be introduced into or attached to the Convention.
