

Section of International and Comparative Law (Annual Meeting 1971)

BE IT RESOLVED, That the American Bar Association recommends that (1) the President of the United States transmit to the Senate, for its advice and consent, the Vienna Convention on the Law of Treaties, adopted by a United Nations Conference of plenipotentiaries on 05/22/69, opened for signature on 05/23/69, and signed by the United States on 04/24/70; and (2) that the Senate give its advice and consent to ratification of that Convention without reservations;

BE IT RESOLVED Further, That the Chairman of the Association's Section of International and Comparative Law, or any person or persons designated by him, be, and they are hereby, authorized to appear before any appropriate committee of the Senate and any department of the Government to express the views of the Association as hereinabove set forth; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy hereof, certified by the Secretary of the Association, be transmitted to the President of the United States, the Secretary of State and the Chairman of the Foreign Relations Committee of the Senate.
