

Rule 4.13**Reimbursement or Waiver of Charges for Travel-Related Expenses****Judge James Glazebrook****November 7, 2005**

Judge James Glazebrook questions the effect that Rule 4.13 (which limits reimbursement to necessary travel and lodging) and Comment 2 (which requires judges to discover and to consider a number of factors before attending expense-paid educational seminars, including the source of funding), will have on federal judges who seek reimbursement from the ABA for travel, lodging, and meals in connection with the work of the National Conference of Federal Trial Judges and the National Conference of Appellate Judges? He asks what effect will this might have on Judicial Division membership.
