RULES REGARDING THE AMERICAN BAR ASSOCIATION-BAR/BRI BAR REVIEW SCHOLARSHIP

The American Bar Association's Law Student Division (ABA/LSD) and BAR/BRI will be awarding *partial* bar review scholarships to ABA/LSD members who are December 2010 or May 2011 graduates to be applied toward BAR/BRI Bar Review tuition. Scholarships will vary in amount depending upon the applicant's financial condition and the size of the applicant pool. These scholarships are not assignable and may not be combined with any other BAR/BRI discount, other than the early enrollment discount.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be active members of the ABA/LSD and must not have a commitment for full-time legal employment with a salary in excess of \$30,000 by the application deadline. **Furthermore, all applicants expressly agree to renounce the scholarship if they receive a commitment for full-time employment paying in excess of \$30,000 per year by graduation from law school.**

APPLICATION PROCESS

Please complete all of the below-requested information. Applicants **MUST** also include a statement explaining why a scholarship is deserved (amount of loans, lack of job or job prospects, commitment to law, etc.).

For February and July 2011 bar examinees, applications must be postmarked **by November 30, 2010.**

February 2011 bar examinees will receive notification by December 31, 2010.

July 2011 bar examinees will receive notification by March 1, 2011.
