

Pennsylvania Death Penalty Assessment Report
Errata Sheet

- Page 172-73, Chapter Eight, Recommendation #7
While the report accurately notes that the federal public defender offices in the Eastern, Middle, and Western Districts of Pennsylvania represent death-row inmates in federal *habeas corpus* proceedings, it should also have made clear that there is no state funding of state post-conviction cases.
- Page 176, Chapter Eight, Recommendation #10
The report does not make clear that there is no basis for filing a successive petition based on defense counsel's ineffectiveness. As described in *Commonwealth v. Gamboa-Taylor*, "a claim for ineffective assistance of counsel does not save an otherwise untimely petition for review on the merits." 753 A.2d 780, 785 (2000).
