



Comprehensive Immigration Reform Action in the 110th Congress

On May 15, 2007, the ABA sent a [letter](#) to House sponsors of STRIVE supporting comprehensive immigration reform legislation.

On March 15, 2007, the Christina Fiflis [testified](#) on behalf of the ABA before the House Homeland Security Subcommittee on Border, Maritime and Global Counterterrorism outlining a number of steps that should be taken to address the lack of meaningful access to legal information and legal representation experienced by many immigrants in detention.

On February 1, 2007, the ABA wrote a [letter](#) to the Department of Homeland Security regarding Detainee Transfer Standard.

On January 31, 2007, the ABA wrote a [letter](#) to the Department of Homeland Security regarding petition for rule-making to promulgate regulations governing detention standards for immigration detainees.
