### Young Lawyers to Draft Wills for Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, Taylorsville and Utah Transit Authority First Responders

(SALT LAKE CITY, April 29, 2008) — The Young Lawyers Division of the Utah State Bar, together with the Utah State Bar and the [Wills for Heroes Foundation](#), will be drafting free wills for as many as 200 Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, Taylorsville and Utah Transit Authority police and fire officers on Friday, May 2 from 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. MST at Utah Transit Authority Offices in Salt Lake City, Utah.

Wills for Heroes is a unique pro bono program created by the Wills for Heroes Foundation that provides free wills and other basic estate planning documents to emergency first responders, their spouses and domestic partners. First responders include police officers, firefighters, paramedics and corrections officers.

To date, Wills for Heroes has assisted more than 8,000 emergency first responders in several states: Alabama, Arizona, California, Georgia, Illinois, Minnesota, North Carolina, South Carolina, Texas, Utah and Virginia. Additional programs are in development in Connecticut, Kansas, Louisiana, Michigan, Mississippi, Oklahoma, Ohio and Tennessee.
