



National Reunification Day

The Achieving Reunification Center (ARC), a program of the City of Philadelphia Department of Human Services (DHS), will host Philadelphia's 3rd Annual Reunification Day Celebration on June 16th, 2011. The Achieving Reunification Center is a "one stop" center providing a host of services designed to help parents with children in placement overcome barriers to family reunification. Services include workforce development, counseling support and parent education, housing and financial counseling, fatherhood support, and technology-based learning.

Reunification is a key priority for DHS and we believe that all families with children in out-of-home placement have resources to achieve reunification through the provision of appropriate support services that ensure the child's safety and strengthen the family's ability to become stable and self-sufficient.

The goal of the Reunification Event is to celebrate the accomplishments and dedication of parent/caregivers who have successfully completed ARC's program and have been reunified with their children. The event will also recognize the work of the entire Professional Service Team in helping families achieve reunification.
