



## **SECTION RECOMMENDATION ADOPTED BY ABA HOUSE**

The ABA House of Delegates during its Midyear Meeting in Chicago approved the Section of Family Law Recommendation 102. The recommendation was also co-sponsored by the Section of Individual Rights and Responsibilities, Commission on Domestic Violence and Commission on Homelessness and Poverty.

The recommendation was adopted by voice vote of the House of Delegates on Monday, February 13, 2006.

The recommendation reads as follows:

**RESOLVED**, That the American Bar Association opposes legislation and policies that prohibit, limit, or restrict placement into foster care of any child on the basis of sexual orientation of the proposed foster parent when such foster care placement is otherwise appropriate under the applicable law of the state, territory, or tribe.
