### Judge Debra H. Lehrmann Receives Outstanding Journal Article Award

Since 1977, the Texas Bar Foundation has annually recognized the author of an outstanding article, comment or other writing relating to the legal profession, the practice of law or substantive law as applied to the practice of law. This year's recipient is **Debra H. Lehrmann**, Judge of the 360<sup>th</sup> District Court, Fort Worth, for "The Child's Voice—An Analysis of the Methodology Used to Involve Children in Custody Litigation" Texas Bar Journal, Nov. 2002.

Judge Lehrmann has been active in the Section of Family Law of the ABA for the last several years, having served on the committee to develop standards for the representation of children in custody cases and on the custody committee.
